Nominating a Thesis Topic

❖ *Student-developed topic*

Students may develop their own topic, provided that they have a WAM greater than 65. Students should locate an appropriate supervisor from within PV who will agree to supervise their topic. A one-page summary of the topic should be attached to this form before approaching a prospective supervisor.

Supervisors from other Schools of UNSW may only be allowed with permission from the Thesis Coordinator. A co-supervisor from within PV must also be organised by the student. For permission to have a UNSW academic from outside PV supervise your thesis, please email Merlinde Kay m.kay@unsw.edu.au.

The Centre also encourages students who wish to do an industry-led thesis topic. In this case the mentor from industry would be the student's co-supervisor and the student would have to locate a suitable supervisor from within CPVE. A one-page summary signed by the industry mentor should be attached to this form before approaching a prospective supervisor from the Centre.
